
### YEAR FOUR ... WE'RE STARTING TO SEE POSITIVE TRENDS!

The **Franklin County Youth Survey** is an anonymous, in-depth survey that gives us a detailed picture of what's going on with kids in Franklin County right now.



SCHOOLS IN FRANKLIN COUNTY With prevention, it takes time to see results! Year four of the *Franklin County Youth Survey* showed clear positive trends in the wellbeing of youth in Franklin County, including reductions in substance use, improvements in mental and physical health indicators, and increases in protective factors in all areas (family, peers, school, out-of-school time).



# The Yes Card

A **Yes Card** is an electronic gift card that can be used to pay for youth activities from a list of approved providers.

The co-op card is a \$400 Yes Card given to K-12th grade youth, who have experienced parental incarceration/ substance use disorder, homelessness or abuse/neglect.

Batons, basketballs and boxing gloves shared the stage with violins, cellos and even steel drums for this vibrant celebration of community, recreation and prevention.

Cellist and composer Ben Sollee and KSU Associate Director of Athletics Jackie Gordon Duvall served as Masters of Ceremony.

The showcase, intended to raise awareness about the Yes Card, was presented by the Franklin County Health Department's Just Say Yes coalition in partnership with the Franklin County Agency for Substance Abuse Policy, Kentucky State University, the Kentucky Arts Council, and Noise for Jordon, a charitable fund established in memory of beloved Frankfort drummer Jordon Ellis, who died by suicide last year.


